



We make the second candle represent the light of Noah. Much like Judah Maccabee and his father, Noah was one man who stood up to the evil of his day. The torch was passed from Adam to Noah's family, as Noah's father would have been alive during Adam's life. Pretty amazing to think about! There were eight people in the ark, and I connect it to the eight days of Hanukkah. I explain how the eight "lights" in the ark were not meant to stay in the ark but are meant to be shared with the world. We can't keep our light under a bushel!



Scavenger Hunt - Instructions

You leave one clue out to give to the participant to start the game. All of the rest of the clues can be hidden in what ever order you would like. You can use all the clues or some of the clues.

Instructions:

- 1. Pick the clues you want to use.
- 2. Pick the first clue to leave out.

Finally, we come to the end of time as we know it where the Messiah comes back to usher in the final candle, the Light of the Millennium. This is the thousand-year reign of Messiah where He will be the Light coming directly from the new temple.

"But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. The city had no need of the sun or the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. **The Lamb is its light.**" Revelation 21:22-23



LIGHT OF EVANGELISM

From there, the Jewish and Gentile believers spread the light together for 2000 years until they came to us. So the seventh candle represents us. We read the scriptures that talk about us being the light of the world and how we are not to hide our light under a bushel. We are getting closer and closer to the point of coming full circle back to the first night, the light of creation. The original intent of the Creator was to share Himself, the Light, to all the nations (Hebrew: Goyim, which is the same word for Gentiles). The original plan of God was that there would always be one people under Him, and the light would continually be shining in and through His people.



LIGHT OF THE GENTILES

The sixth light is for the Gentiles. We read Acts 10 and explain how God called Peter to go give the gospel to Cornelius but how Peter resisted, thinking that the Gentiles were unclean. I talk about how the Spirit finally opened his eyes in verse 28 and he realized that the sheet of unclean animals was representative of the Gentiles and that the vision was not about animals at all. He then took the Light to the Gentiles.



LIGHT OF MESSIAH

The fifth candle is when the Light of Messiah was passed to His disciples. They were told to take that light to the rest of the world. Matthew 5:14-16 has Yeshua telling His disciples, "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead, they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."



LIGHT OF TORAH

Day four is Israel, with Moses at the head. The light was reintroduced to him at the burning bush and the miraculous story of the people of Israel being redeemed from Egypt. We talk about the Exodus story and how it foreshadows our Lord Yeshua, who "Passed Over" us and our sins because we put His blood over the doors of our hearts. Then we talk about how the Light came in the form of the Torah commandments and read scriptures that talk about His Law being a light unto our path.



LIGHT OF ABRAHAM

The third light is Abraham, the Father of the people of God. This is where the light was reintroduced to the people of earth and where obedience through faith really begins to come to the forefront when Isaac is bound to the altar. On this night we talk about how the beautiful picture of Abraham preparing to sacrifice his son is a picture of Yeshua offering Himself as a substitute for all of us.
